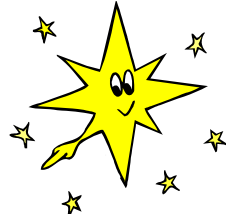
As always, a massive thank you for your continued support. What a lovely whole school community we have! I am the luckiest Head ever!
