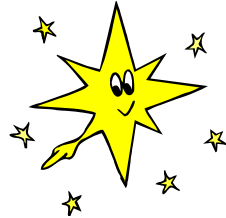
"It was scary because I fell off my pedal bike. Then I got back on and rode a bike!" Oakley
